Homestead Student Earns Perfect Score on ACT

Junior Max Kroft Scores 36 Out of 36

MEQUON, Wis. — Homestead High School junior Max Kroft scored a perfect 36 on the ACT exam. The ACT is a national college entrance exam that tests in the areas of English, reading, math and science. Kroft took the test in March.

Nationally, one-tenth of one percent of students who take the ACT earn the top score. In 2016, only 2,235 of nearly 2.1 million students earned a composite score of 36.

“We are so proud of Max and this rare achievement,” said Principal Brett Bowers. “Max has a well-deserved reputation at Homestead for being a dedicated, serious student who challenges himself academically. Without a doubt, his years of hard work and scholarship have led him to this special accomplishment.”

Max is a member of the Homestead track and math teams and is enrolled in several advanced placement courses.
