MTSD Board of Education Seeks Applications for Vacant Seat
Qualified electors asked to submit application by May 24, 2017

MEQUON, Wis. — The Mequon-Thiensville Board of Education seeks applications from qualified electors interested in serving the children, families and citizens of Mequon and Thiensville and its school district as a member of the MTSD Board of Education. The Board of Education vacancy is due to resignation.

Applicants will engage in an interview process during an open session with the board, following which the board will select one individual to serve as a member of the Board of Education in order to complete the unfinished term that was created by a recent resignation.

The successful candidate will serve from June 20, 2017 - April 22, 2018. The appointed will be eligible to submit his/her candidacy in the Wisconsin State Spring Election in 2018 for a new three-year term starting April 23, 2018.

Applicants are asked to indicate their interest by completing an online application, including a letter of interest and resume by Wednesday, May 24, 2017 at 12 p.m. Interested applicants can find more information and complete the online application at www.mtsd.k12.wi.us/BoardApplication.

Current Board President Stephanie Clark recently tendered her resignation, effective June 20, 2017, leading to the vacant seat. Clark said that increasing family commitments, strong board and a deep leadership team made it the right time for her to take a step back.

Process and Timeline for Filling Board Vacancy	
May 24, 2017, 12 p.m.	Applicants must submit all application materials, including online application, resume and letter of interest.
May 25, 2017	Applicants will be informed if they have been invited to participate in candidate interviews, which will take place on June 5, 2017.
June 5, 2017, 6 p.m.	Candidates will be interviewed in open session by the Board of Education. A schedule will be provided. Questions from board members and responses from candidates will be the only commentary in order. After deliberation in closed session, the board will select the successful candidate that evening in open session.
June 20, 2017	The successful candidate will take the oath of office as a member of the MTSD Board of Education.
April 22, 2018	Term ends; candidate is eligible to run for new three-year term in the 2018 spring election.
