**City of Mequon to Host Pre-Holiday COVID-19 and Influenza Vaccination Clinics
Beginning November 15**

Beginning Monday, November 15, Midland Health, a local vaccination company, will be holding COVID-19 (Initial and Booster) and influenza vaccination clinics at Mequon City Hall, 11333 N. Cedarburg Road. Clinics will run from 3:00 P.M. – 8:00 P.M. on specific days throughout the months of November and December, as follows:

First Shot and Influenza Clinics:

Nov. 15, 16, 17, 18, & 19: 3:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Second Shot and Influenza Clinics:

Dec. 6, 7, 9, & 10: 3:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m.

All persons 5 years of age and older are eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccination series. To receive a COVID-19 booster (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna), it must be at least 6 months since one completed the primary series. Non-Mequon residents are welcome to participate. To schedule an appointment, please visit Midland Health's [website](#) and click the select date for FLU or COVID. To be fully vaccinated, individuals will need two shots over a three-week period. Participants will be able to sign-up for a second dose clinic after the first dose clinics are completed. For questions or help with the scheduler, please call Midland Health at 262-754-3130.

COVID-19 vaccinations will be provided at no cost to individuals, but insurance will be billed for a vaccination administration fee or influenza shots. Individuals should bring a copy of their photo ID and an insurance, Medicare or Medicaid card if they have one, and a completed Midland Health consent form. Those without insurance will also be eligible for the COVID-19 shot. Midland Health's consent form with the CDC's prevaccination checklist for the COVID-19 vaccine is available [here](#).
