Students grades K-8 work with Teams of 2-7 age-like peers to solve 7 STEAM-based challenges supported by Parent Volunteers



Purpose at MTSD: to provide our students experiences and challenges to explore their creativity through STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math)

Notable Information:

- **DI is kid-powered!**
- **Activity fee of \$75 required**
- **Regular season runs from October to end of March**
- **Weekly meetings held after school or in the evenings**
 - **Teams have the decision to create their own practice schedule!**
- **Student teams select and work together to solve 1 of 7 challenges by problem-solving and working together. Solutions are performed at a regional tournament in March.**
